The **Use and Assessment of Display Screen Equipment** course is intended for managers, safety officers, or other employees who have responsibility for staff who use display screen equipment (DSE) on a regular basis and are therefore required to carry out the assessment of such workstations. It may also be suitable for the individual users of display screen equipment, if they are actually required to carry out their own work station self assessments.
