The **NEBOSH National Certificate in Construction Health and Safety** is the most widely held Health & Safety, Level 3 qualification, in the construction industry UK wide. It is not a qualification purely for Health and Safety specialists. Anyone with no previous Health and Safety knowledge is welcome to apply.
