Pre-requisites

Candidates do not require any formal entry requirements.

Aim of the course

The **NEBOSH National General Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety** is the most widely held Health & Safety qualification in the UK. It is aimed at safety officers and anyone with responsibility for Health and Safety at work. It is not a qualification purely for Health and Safety specialists and anyone with no previous Health and Safety knowledge is welcome to apply.

Who should attend?

- Health and Safety Officers or people with some Health and Safety responsibilities
- People interested in pursuing Health and Safety as a potential career.
