

Working at Heights

Pre-requisites

Candidates do not require any formal entry requirements.

Aim of the course

The **Working at Heights** course is intended to enable organisations or companies to be compliant with the Working at Height Regulations. It will encourage staff to consider the risks associated with working at height, plan ahead using risk assessment and follow safe procedures while undertaking work.

Who Should attend

Work at Height Regulations place a duty on employers, managers, self employed people and anyone supervising staff in the workplace, as they apply to all work at heights where there is a risk of a fall liable to cause personal injury.

Objectives of the course

- Overview of other relevant safety laws
- Employees safety duties and responsibilities
- Risk assessment of hazards associated with height
- Working locations and conditions
- Access equipment and ladder safety
