- Improvisation
- Working on text
- Building a character
- Working on audition monologues
- Classical and contemporary
- Working on scenes
- Understanding direction
- Preparation for performance

- Learn how to create a character on stage
- Develop your overall self-confidence
- Learn how to work in groups to develop a performance
