This 1-day course ensures learners are able to understand, and where relevant, apply the following skills when helping an adult in the workplace or at home. Learners will develop the skills and confidence to help someone who is:

 unresponsive and not breathing, including how to use of an automated external defibrillator (AED)

- unresponsive and breathing
- having a seizure or anaphylactic shock allergic reaction and eppi pen administration
- choking
- bleeding
- suffering from shock and internal bleeding
- suffering from a burn.

What skills will I gain?

- Learn how to deal with accidents and injuries
- Learn how CPR works and how to use a defibrillator
- Understand the correct action to take in an emergency
- Develop your confidence in dealing with injuries
- Understand how first aid skills are applied in the work environment, as well as everyday life

- Gain valuable team working and communication skills by taking part in practical activities
