Entry Requirements

To access this course you are required to have:

- Four or more GCSEs at Grade 3 or above including English and maths

What will I learn?

- GCSE sciences (including biology, chemistry and physics)
- Level 2 project in a specialism of your choice

What skills will I gain?

By studying this course you will:

- Learn about the English language
- Develop your understanding of writing techniques
- Learn how to interpret information for different meanings
- Functional elements of maths
- Nature of science and scientific processes
- Relationships between hypotheses, evidence, theories and explanations
- Observational, practical, modeling, enquiry and problem solving skills
- Gain valuable team working and communication skills by taking part in group activities
- Problem solving
- Analysis and evaluation skills

All GCSEs are assessed through exams and controlled assessments.
