Is this course right for me?

If you're interested in nails and want an exciting career in the beauty industry this course will give you the skills and knowledge you need to become a qualified nail technician and provide nail enhancement treatments to clients.

You will attend college one evening per week, for 3.5 hours, and will learn a broad range of skills including gel nail enhancements, how to promote nail products and services, client care and communication and health and safety in the salon - all the skills you need for a successful career in the industry.

The course will also give you the qualification needed for insurance purposes to perform all types of nail enhancements.

Please note: you will be expected to purchase your own nail kit, costing approximately £150, and college-branded uniform, costing approximately £50 - order forms will be provided before the start of the course and fnancial support may be available to help with these costs.

Also, if you earn less than £30,000 per year and aged 19 or over, you could study this course for FRFF!

Entry Requirements

To access this course you are required to have: :

- Manicure City & Guilds Level 2 Award
- Undertake a salon skills session in which you will be required to meet members of the teaching team and demonstrate filing and polishing nails or carrying out a hand massage
- Purchase a beauty kit and college-branded uniform (details will be provided at enrolment)

What will I learn?

During this course you will learn how to:

- Provide and maintain nail enhancements
- Demonstrate client care and communication skills
- Promote products and services to clients in a salon
- Monitor and maintain health and safety practice in the salon

What skills will I gain?

By studying this course you will:

- Learn how to prepare, apply and maintain gel/acrylic nail extensions
- Develop confidence in dealing with a wide range of clients
- Improve your communication and customer service skills
- Gain knowledge and experience of working as part of a team in a commercial salon

- Assignments
- End of unit multiple choice exam
