Entry Requirements

To access this course you are required to have:

- Level 2 in English*
- Knowledge of Photoshop
- Ideally, your own digital SLR camera. However, one will be provided during lesson times if you do not have one

*Applications from adults without the necessary qualifications but with relevant experience will be considered on an individual basis.

What will I learn?

- **Basic Photography Techniques:** Understand your camera settings, from aperture to shutter speed and ISO.
- **Introduction to Lighting:** Learn how natural and artificial light affects your shots and how to control it for the best results.
- **Studio Practice:** Get introduced to basic studio equipment and lighting setups, enabling you to take your first steps in controlled environments like portrait or still-life photography.
- **Digital and Analogue Skills:** Explore the basics of both modern digital photography and classic film photography.
- **Post-Production:** Learn simple image editing techniques to enhance your photos and correct exposure, colour, and composition.

What skills will I gain?

By studying this course you will:

- Explore appropriate camera techniques
- Use the studio and other equipment to produce test shots and develop your range of techniques
- Research and evaluate other photographers' work
- Develop and experiment with your own creative images
- Follow live briefs and fulfil them within the given timescale
- Produce a portfolio of your work

How will I be assessed?

This is an assignment based course so there are no exams. You will be continually assessed throughout the programme.

What can I do next?

The skills you will learn from this course will enable you to:

• Progress on to UAL Level 3 Award and Certificate in Photography, or further study in the art and design, photography or graphic design subject area
