Successful completion of the qualification will give you a fundamental understanding of the roles and responsibilities of a teacher/trainer in relation to legislation, equality, diversity, inclusivity and meeting the needs of learners. You will also be able to sequence learning, plan and deliver sessions using appropriate resources and teaching methods, and identify the characteristics of effective assessment and feedback.

Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements for this qualification however if you wish to obtain employment as a trainer/teacher you must:

- Have achieved a qualification and have experience in that subject/skill at the appropriate level (minimum Level 3).
- Have achieved Level 2 in English, maths and ICT
- Attend an interview to determine your interest, commitment and suitability for the course.

- The roles, responsibilities and relationships in education and training
- Inclusive teaching and learning approaches
- Assessment of learners
- Facilitating learning and development for individuals
- Facilitating learning and development in groups
- Understanding principles and practices of assessment

- Have the opportunity to develop a wide range of teaching, learning and assessment skills covered within the course structure
- Develop wider skills needed to begin your journey into successful and effective teaching Improve your team working skills
- Develop your presentation and communication skills and become an active listener
